A very elegant Champagne that has a fine mousse, with a lovely, fine and biscuity character.

3. v Champagne Hébrart, Brut Rosé 1er Cru, France | £55.00
This rich and elegant rosé has complex aromas of red fruit, through to a long flavoursome finish.

Easy drinking, fresh and zesty with a hint of apricot and an Italian bitter twist on the finish.
5. Chenin Blanc, Hazy View, Western Cape, South Africa | £4.90, £6.75, £19.95
Rounded flavours of ripe melon and crystallised pear with a fresh balanced hint of sweetness.
6. Chardonnay, Viña Edmara, Valle Central, Chile | £5.20, £7.50, £21.95
A zesty citrus flavour enhanced by ripe tropical fruit and vanilla notes, creamy and appealing.
7. Viognier, Pays d'Oc, Tournée du Sud, Languedoc-Roussillon, France | £5.20, £7.50, £21.95
Sun-drenched peach and apricot characters, along with a merest hint of ginger and jasmine.
8. Pinot Grigio, Venezia, Novità, Veneto, Italy | £5.40, £7.95, £22.95
Fresh, crisp and clean Pinot Grigio with vibrant pear and citrus flavours.
9. v Rioja Blanco 'Rivallana', Ondarre, Rioja, Spain | £5.40, £7.95, £22.95
Crystalline fruits and vibrant lemon and melon notes through to a zesty finish.
10. Picpoul de Pinet, Tournée du Sud, Languedoc-Roussillon, France | £6.70, £9.75, £26.95
A poised dry white wine, showing a creamy character of apricot and green apple.
11. Sauvignon Blanc, Faultline, Marlborough, New Zealand | £7.00, £9.75, £27.95
Typical notes of passion fruit and citrus with a fresh and herbaceous flavour.

A medium style rosé showing strawberry aromas complemented by a fruity and smooth flavour.
13. v 'Invitation Rosé', Château de Campuget, Costières de Nîmes, France | £6.20, £8.90, £24.95
A fruity and floral Rosé showing bright berried fruit and spice characters through to a crisp finish.
14. v Pinot Grigio Blush, Sacchetto, Venezia, Italy | £5.90, £8.50, £24.95
An ultra pale rosé with fruity red berried flavours and a delicately refreshing character.

Red and black fruit aromas of juicy cherries and plums with a touch of chocolate.
17. v Malbec, El Camino, Mendoza, Argentina | £5.80, £8.25, £23.95
A wine full of the flavour of spice and blackberry against a smoky background.
18. v Rioja Crianza, Hugonell, Rioja, Spain | £6.50, £9.25, £26.95
A smooth Rioja blend of rich strawberry fruit, beautifully integrated vanilla and coconut flavours.
19. 'The Black Shiraz Metal Label', Berton Vineyard, South Eastern Australia | £6.75, £9.75, £27.95
A fruit bomb of a wine bursting with Morello cherry fruit and minty blackcurrant aromas.
20. v Pinot Noir Gran Reserva, Viña Echeverría, Valle de Colchagua, Chile | £7.10, £9.85, £28.00
This attractive Pinot Noir combines aromas of cooked strawberries, mocha and cloves with soft vanilla.
21. v Fleurie, Olivier Ravier, Beaujolais, France | £29.95
Subtle floral aromas surrounding a core of fresh red fruits enhanced by nuances of fennel.
